<p>If you are Involved in an Accident</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Keep calm. <input type="checkbox"/> Stop as soon as you can. <input type="checkbox"/> Offer assistance and give aid to the injured. <input type="checkbox"/> Call the appropriate law enforcement agency (local or regional Police) immediately to report any accident resulting in injury to any person, or motor vehicle damage. <input type="checkbox"/> If no personal injury is involved and damage is less than \$500, vehicles should be moved to clear the traffic flow. <input type="checkbox"/> Complete as much of the information in this booklet as possible including names of witnesses. <input type="checkbox"/> Take pictures of accident scene and vehicles. Refer to last page for instructions on what pictures to take.
